Kaps For Kids 1,300 Baseball Hats

Alex and Conor are two 11 year old boys who want to do something special for the children and adults of Uganda. Alex had seen the photos of Ron Hubbard (in photo with wife, Becky) distributing several baseball hats during his last trip to Uganda. Alex was then inspired to conduct a hat collection of his own. Starting with his own closet, he gathered all of the baseball hats he had. From then on, the hat collection project was off and running

A few weeks into the project, the total hat count was 450. The boys went to houses in the neighborhood, where they introduced their project by showing everyone a picture of the children in Uganda grinning from ear to ear wearing their new hats. Men who had been collecting hats for over 25 years took one look at the flyer - "folded" - and handed over ALL their hats. These boys truly demonstrate the heart of Jesus in their desire to brighten the lives of children and adults in Uganda. To date a total of 1,300 caps have been donated with more caps still coming!

Nothing spells ministry success like passion in action – especially when that passion in action continues long after the minister has returned home. LOBO congratulates Anita Liu, mission team member in 2007 and 2008, on the success of “Project Lao” which she spearheaded at Rutgers Community Christian Church in New Jersey. Anita was moved to action during her second trip to Uganda when she visited Apac and witnessed the devastation of the area and its people. When her team asked the local pastor to identify the people’s greatest need, he responded, “Bibles.” He knew that a land devoid of God’s Word would remain desolate.

Beginning in January of 2009 “Project Lao” included in its goals the provision of 1,000 Bibles in the Lango language, a sub-dialect of Lao for Apac Village in northern war-ravaged Uganda. At \$8.00 a bible, this goal is obviously quite ambitious. Our God is limited only by our human understanding of His greatest, however, and His ample provision prevailed. Anita’s project has raised \$13,000. God is certainly good!

PARTNERSHIP WITH SPORTS OUTREACH

LOBO is pleased to announce our partnership with Sports Outreach, an American Organization with a ministry site in Kampala. Sports Outreach serves the poorest areas in and around the city by providing sports activities, time for evangelism, and a vehicle for connecting new believers into local churches. LOBO is adding four new slum areas to its circle of Medical Clinics, and Sports Outreach will be with us! When we work together, we see God's plan of action for loving more people.

The village is called Jjokolera — a village where the middle generation of adults have been wiped out by HIV/AIDS. Elderly grandparents are raising young children, struggling to meet the basic daily needs of the young ones.
