Our Trip to the North - Apac

After traveling 6 hours and crossing the Nile River on a ferry, we arrived in Apac hot and tired, but excited about what God had planned for us. The next morning the team was off and running. We visited two local



schools where we passed out pencils, exercise books, and toothbrushes to over 1500 school children. Later, approximately 3500 people came to greet us as we distributed over 300 gardening hoes (bringing the total to 700 hoes) and 2,000 pounds of bean seeds. The village elders called me outside to let me know that they wanted to GIVE me an acre of the land. The photo at the top right shows Melyssa, Gaila and I pointing to the land that was presented to me. In the photo on the left are several women lined up to receive their seeds for planting. The top photo shows Hannah dancing at the end of the "ceremony" with scores of Uganda women.



The Photo at the far left is our famous "Singing in the Rain" song with hand movements — "thumbs up". This silly song with crazy words and hand motions is in constant demand by the Ugandans and always brings out the child in all of us.

Treating the Physical & Spiritual



With several medical professionals on team #1, we were able to conduct 2 full medical clinics and 5 deworming clinics. Top photo - Aindrea, Dr. Sam and Dr. Godfrey check out



the medicines available in our pharmacy. God continues to provide more opportunities for medical clinics. To date, we have 15 sites which require return visits for medication to be effective. In our Prayer Corner in the slums - Jim, Hannah and Gaila pray for a child who requested prayer.
